Edmund A. Gray Company has been manufacturing pipe nipples since 1910. Quality here isn't a department — it's the job of everyone in this company, from the first sales call to the last mile of delivery, and it doesn't stop until the customer is satisfied.

The Right Material, Verified on Arrival

We start with fabrication-quality pipe, priced competitively but never at the expense of quality. Every incoming shipment of welded steel pipe is inspected against ASTM A53/A53M before it enters production.

Manufactured to Recognized Standards

Every pipe nipple we manufacture meets ASTM A733 (welded and seamless carbon steel and stainless steel pipe nipples) and ASME B1.20.1 (general-purpose pipe threads) — the standards that superseded the federal WW-N-351 specification when it was canceled in 1990. Our gauging tolerances run tighter than either standard requires, because meeting spec is the floor, not the goal.

Trained Hands, Six Months Minimum

New production operators train under direct supervision for a minimum of six months before they're trusted to run to our standards on their own.

Inspected by Eye, Every Piece

Every finished nipple is individually inspected by hand at the packing department before it's cartoned or bundled, with exact count and correct packaging verified for every container.

On Time, In Full, Every Order

Our warehouse, shipping, and will-call teams treat every order — large or small — as the top priority. Turnaround time, fill rate, and accuracy are the numbers we're measured on, and the reputation we work to keep.

Quality Is Everyone's Job
